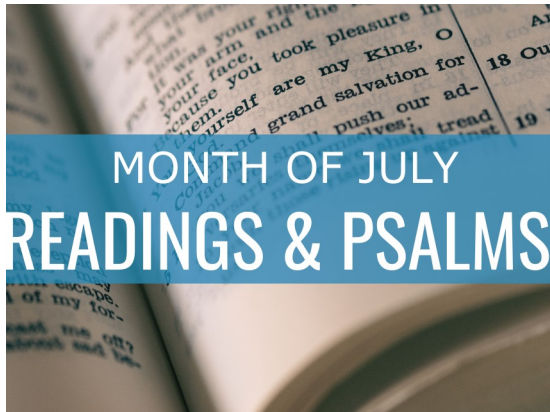
Our Men's Bible Study group is taking their summer hiatus the month of July. They will resume Wednesday, August 3rd.
