Good Shepherd will be housing the homeless again this winter. We are sharing a week with London Bridge Baptist and will serve from Sunday, **December 18th thru Wednesday, December 21**st . This is the evening meal on Sunday thru the breakfast meal the following Wednesday. Please mark your calendars.

SHELTER

We are going to do things differently this year ensuring all NEW protocols are in place. Each one of our guests will have a designated space and will need permission to leave that space. This will limit the number of folks in the restrooms and standing around outside to a minimum. Due to the restrictions, we will deliver the meals directly to them. We will not have them line up to receive their meals as we had done in the past. The new guidelines will afford you the opportunity to support this wonderful outreach. You will be able to sign up to simply serve a meal, provide the food for a specific meal or make a donation to help cover the overall costs. We need volunteers in all capacities. Additionally, we will have pre-planned menus to make the evening meals easier.

When the weather is nice we tend to forget those who have no shelter. With the recent cold weather it's time for us to remember our local homeless community.
