HVAC System

The vote passed to replace the sanctuary gas heating/air conditioning unit. \$22,000 was approved for the new Carrier unit (\$20,000 for the unit, \$2,000 to cover unforeseen costs). The auxiliary electric unit is also experiencing issues and we pray will be an easy repair. Building Fund, Building Maintenance Fund, and Contingency Funds will be used to cover costs. The Building Fund and Building Maintenance Funds will be depleted. Donations toward the new unit will be appreciated. As of December 31st we have received \$1450 toward the unit. Thank you!
